**UPON HEARING** Counsel for the applicant local authority, the father, the guardian and the Education Authority of the London Borough of Camden

**AND UPON** considering a quantity of written material comprising copies of internet articles and links to recorded material apparently posted by the mother, Ella Draper, and Ms Sabine McNeill

**AND UPON** the clerk to Mrs Justice PAUFFLEY having notified all parties of this court hearing by email on 9 February 2015 at 13.08

**AND UPON** there being no appearance by Ella Draper; the court having received no notification that she was unable to attend

**AND UPON** the court reflecting upon the discussions between the Judge and Sabine McNeill on 13 and 26 January 2015 relating to the provisions of s.12 of the Administration of Justice Act 1960, s. 97(2) of the Children Act 1989 and the judgment of Mr Justice MUNBY(as he then was) in Re B [2004] 2FLR 142

**IMPORTANT PENAL NOTICE**

**IF YOU THE WITHIN NAMED ELLA DRAPER AND SABINE MCNEILL DO NOT COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER YOU MAY BE HELD TO BE IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND IMPRISONED OR FINED, OR YOUR ASSETS MAY BE SIEZED**

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:-**

1. The following **mandatory injunction** is made against ELLA DRAPER, the mother Respondent mother, and SABINE MCNEILL of the Association of McKenzie Friends:-

a) ELLA DRAPER and SABINE MC NEILL shall forthwith upon service upon them of this order – and by no later than 16.00 on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2015:-

- (i) Delete from any public computer network, internet website and / or social networking website their articles relating to the subject matter of these proceedings;

- (ii) Delete from publicly available electronic sources their postings of all photographs, pictures, images, recordings (voice or video) identifying ALICIA GAREEVA-DEARMAN and GABRIEL GAREEV- DEARMAN.

b) ELLA DRAPER and SABINE MCNEILL are **prohibited by injunction** whether by themselves or by inciting or encouraging any other person:-

- (i) from publishing or broadcasting in any newspaper, magazine, public computer network, internet website, social networking website, sound or television broadcast or cable / satellite service (a) any information relating to these proceedings; (b) any information which either identifies or could lead to the identification of the children as being subject to proceedings and in particular the names, any picture or image, voice and or video recordings of the children; (c) any information which identifies or could lead to the identification of the father, RICKY DEARMAN; (d) any information including the names and addresses of any employee or legal representative of the local authority;
- (ii) from harassing the father, RICKY DEARMAN; and from subjecting him to unlawful and unwarranted psychological intimidation by posting articles and information upon any internet or social networking website accusing him of unlawful activity

2. Liberty to apply on short notice.
